Scope

The Iceland Seafood Group (ISI) is one of the leading suppliers of North Atlantic seafood, a global value-added seafood producer and sales and marketing company. The Group includes three divisions in various countries, both in Europe and South America.

Our mission is to supply sustainably sourced seafood while continuously improving the environmental and social aspects linked to our operations and aligning them with business priorities. With this sustainability policy we declare our ambition to continuously improve the environmental and social impacts, both from our own operations, as well as our supply-chain partners operations.

This Sustainability Policy applies to ISI and its subsidiaries. Our sustainability work has been categorised into Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) aspects, where we have defined objectives for each ESG aspect and the subsequent impacts. Implementation, monitoring, and reporting is also detailed in this policy.

Environmental aspects

We want to build further on the improvements we have already made as well as finding new methods to further strengthen our environmental profile and reduce our overall greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. ISI depends on the continued biodiversity and stability of the ocean ecosystem and therefore places reduction of GHG emissions and sustainable sourcing of seafood high on its agenda.

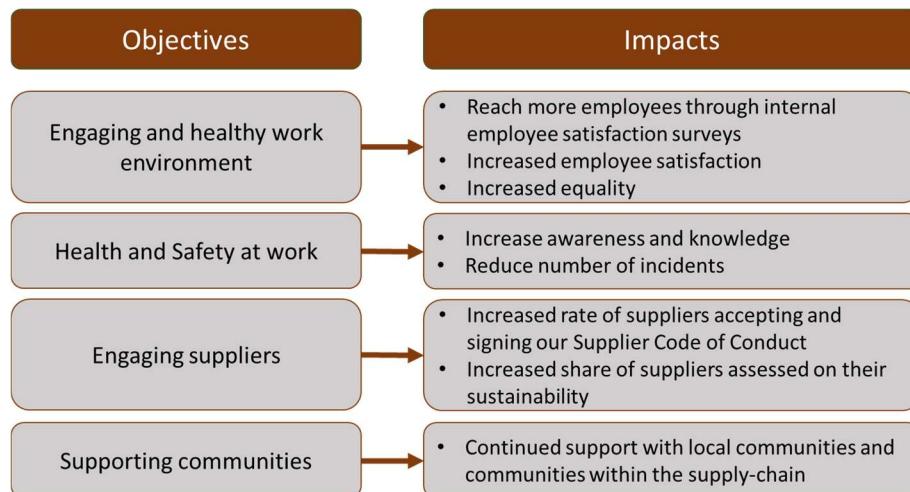

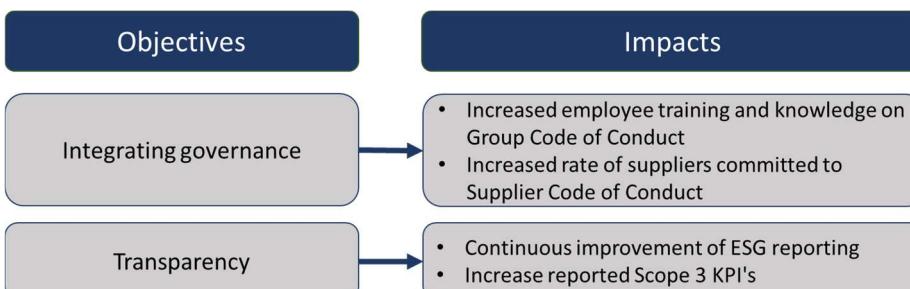
